The apostle Paul said; "Because God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8)

10. What did John the Baptist call Jesus? (1:29)

In the Old Testament times, a lamb without spot or blemish was killed and sacrificed as an innocent substitute, making atonement for the sins of the people. This was a symbol of Jesus Christ, the true Lamb of God who was later to come in the world. John the Baptist recognized Jesus as this sinless substitute who was to die for our sins.

11. By His death on the cross, what did Christ do with our sins? (1:29)

Peter expressed it this way: “Who His own self bore our sins in His own body on the tree... For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just and the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the spirit.”  
(1 Peter 2:24 and 3:18)

The Gospel (good news) of Jesus Christ is: That He is the Son of God; that He “died for our sins according to the Scriptures; and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures.” (1Corinthians 15:3, 4)
